After searching for truth and meaning in life, I accepted Jesus Christ my senior year at the University of Illinois. I asked the Campus Crusade student leader who led me to Christ what I needed to do next. He suggested reading the Bible every day and attending a good church. I started attending Twin City Bible Church later that week back in 1975.

Later that year I entered grad school at the U of I and a year later took a full-time job which began my 25 year career in University of Illinois administration. In 1978, I met my future wife, Ruth, at a leadership training class taught in the pastor's home. To our surprise, we saw each other at the Urbana 79 IVCF Mission conference - where I first understood the direction God had been leading me through my friendships with international students. It was at Urbana 79 that I first heard about ISI. International Students Inc. (ISI) is a Christian friendship ministry to international students.

Ruth and I were married in 1982 and after a year of marriage, we both attended Moody Bible Institute for a one-year intensive Bible program and joined ISI as non-support staff in 1984. In the fall of 2002, after 25 years with the University, God opened the door for me to join ISI on a full-time basis. We have had an International Bible discussion in our home on Friday evenings for the past 21 years. We continue to be amazed at the interest international students have in God's word. Ruth has coordinated the International Women's Fellowship which is a ministry to the wives of international students for 19 years. The group usually meets on Tuesday mornings at our church and provides women with English conversation classes as well as a time for crafts, cooking, or discussing topics of interest – such as the true meaning of Christmas... This has been a time for many women to experience reading the Bible for the first time.

Ruth and I and our seven children live within a few blocks of the University of Illinois where we have the joy and privilege of leading Bible studies and befriending some of the 5000+ talented international students and scholars from around the world who attend the U of I. We enjoy working with local churches to help them better reach out to international students who will be leaders around the world in the next generation.

- Pray that God would direct volunteers to us and that we would be effective in equipping and encouraging individuals and churches who could join us in this strategic ministry.
