President of Biola University, La Mirada, CA.

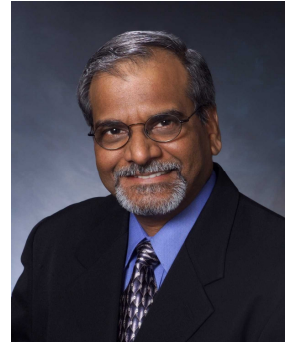
