

Spiritual Gifts Inventory

ISI would like you to access an online spiritual gifts inventory. In order to complete the inventory successfully and to communicate the results, print out this instruction sheet. To ensure that you only need to take this assessment one time, it's important that you follow these instructions carefully. ISI suggests that you read through these instructions *before* beginning this process.

1. Go to: <http://buildingchurch.net/index.htm>
2. Once on this page, notice the navigation buttons on the left-hand side of the screen. The third button from the top of the list is called "Gifted2Serve." Click that button.
3. Read the instructions on that page. At the bottom of the page, click the link that says "Begin the *Gifted2Serve* Inventory." If you wish to read the definitions first, you may do that now, or you may go back through later and read them.
4. Make sure to respond to *every* question. When you reach the end of the survey, click the button that says "Calculate Your Score Now." At this point it is very important that you do NOT leave this page or you'll need to take the inventory again. Your scores will be visible in the box right below the "Calculate Your Score Now" button.
5. Before leaving this page, highlight the box with all your scores and *copy* that information.
6. Without closing the webpage with your scores on it, open a Word document file and *paste* your scores into it. Save that document. Depending on the speed of your computer, this may take some time to complete.
7. Once you have successfully saved your scores to a Word file, you may exit from the webpage with your inventory scores.
8. Put your name and the date of your inventory on the Word document.
9. Email that Word document to your coach, as well as to recruitment@isiwebnet.net.
10. You're finished!
